A Spray Painting Permit must be obtained prior to the commencement of any spray painting operations involving compressors, spray guns, paint, primers, solvents, thinners, or other coating materials on the hardstand facility. All spray painting activities must be undertaken in accordance with the approved method of work, applicable health and safety legislation, environmental requirements, and recognised industry best practices.

By applying for a Spray Painting Permit, the applicant accepts full responsibility for the spray painting activity and all associated risks, including but not limited to overspray, airborne contaminants, environmental pollution, fire hazards, damage to adjacent vessels, vehicles, equipment, and property, and any risks to other hardstand users, contractors, staff, or members of the public.

The permit holder is responsible for ensuring suitable weather conditions exist for spray painting, that appropriate containment measures are in place to prevent overspray and contamination, and that all waste materials are managed and disposed of in accordance with environmental regulations.

Failure to comply with the conditions of this permit, the approved method of work, facility rules, environmental controls, or recognised industry safety standards may result in the suspension or cancellation of the permit, cessation of work, removal from the facility, and liability for any resulting damage, clean-up costs, or regulatory action.
